MRS. JOSIE MURPHY IS BURIED HERE SAT. AFTERNOON

Funeral services were held in the Fielder-Baker chapel Saturday afternoon for Mrs. Emmett Murphy, aged 49, who died Friday evening about 8 o'clock at the home of her daughter Mrs. Poland Burns after a few months illness.

Mrs. Murphy was a resident of Farmersville all her life having been born here May 28, 1891, the daughter of Jeff D. and Sarah Gill Killian. She was a member of the Baptist church.

She is survived by her husband, Emmett Murphy, three daughters, Mrs. Poland Burns, Nadine and Billy Murphy all of Farmersville; five sons, Charles and Richard Murphy of Leonard; Leon Murphy of Greenville; Eugene and Joe Preston Murphy of Farmersville.

The services were conducted by Rev. Matthew Muller, pastor of the First Baptist church.
